As science week approaches, here are some fun home activity's you can do with your child to commemorate science week. This year's theme is under the sea.

Sea ocean exploring water play:

1. Fill a tub full of blue water using water and food colouring.
2. Place sea animals into the tub and sea related materials, such as sand, shells, seaweed and pebbles/rocks.
3. Watch your child role play and identify sea animals.

Blue Playdough:

1. Gather up some flour, salt, cream a tartar, boiling water and some blue food colouring and create some blue playdough.
2. Add some sea animals, natural materials such a shells or sand or pebbles to finish off the under the sea look.

Jelly Fish paper plates:

1. Get all your materials together, you will need paper plates, texters or pencils, cut out strips of paper, glue.
2. Cut paper plate in half
3. Colour in paper plate however you like.
4. Attach strips of paper to the back of the plate.
5. Ta da! you have a Jelly fish.



Potato masher turtles:

1. Grab your mashers and some paper and some green paint.
2. Use a plate and pour the paint on top and stamp down on top of the paint with your masher.
3. The stamp your masher on to the page.
4. Draw some legs and eyes onto your painting to make turtles.
