2. Discuss with your child a range of feelings and emotions they may be feeling and draw how they see themselves in the circle below. (Using a mirror can help with children seeing their emotions)

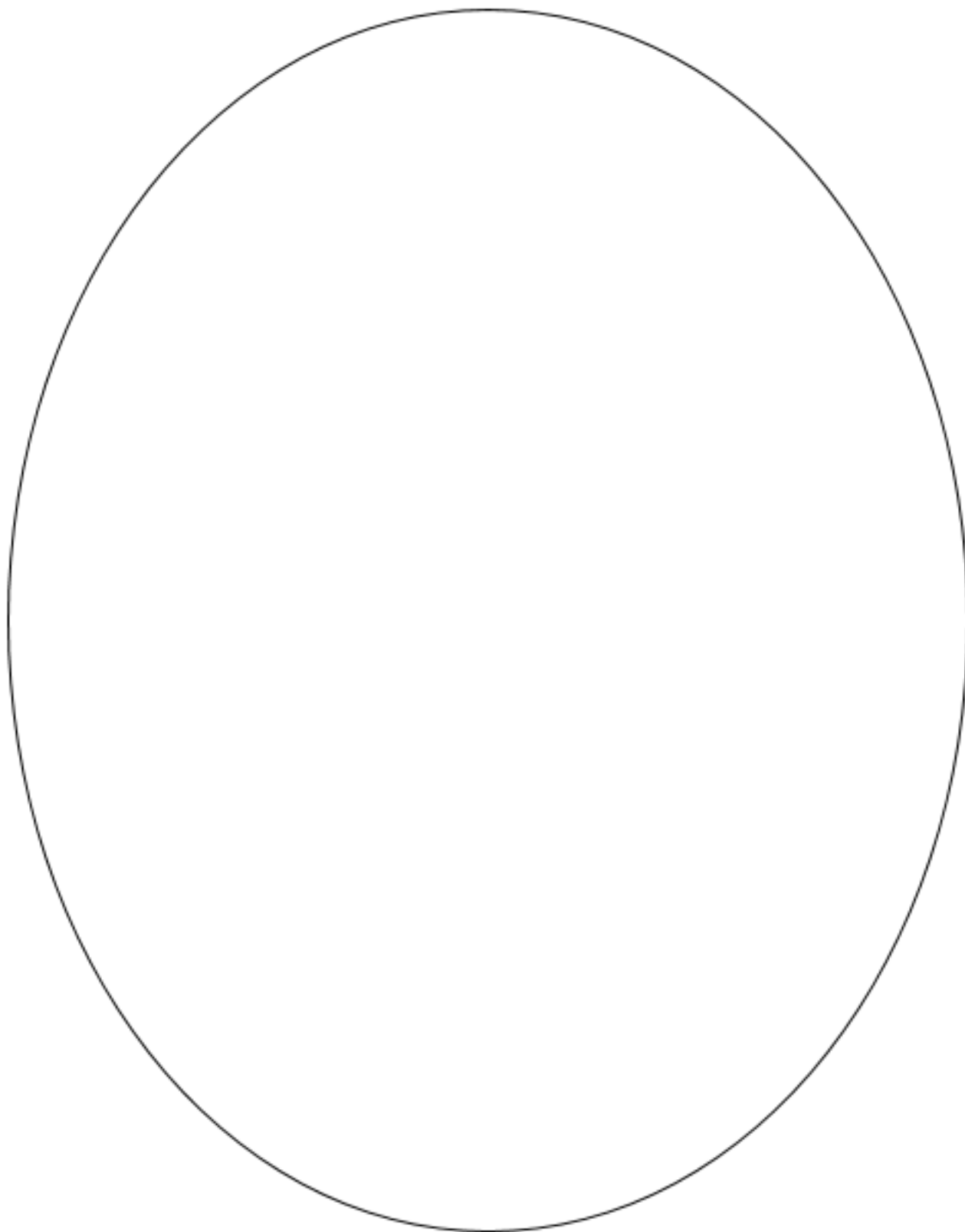
### The Zones of Regulation
