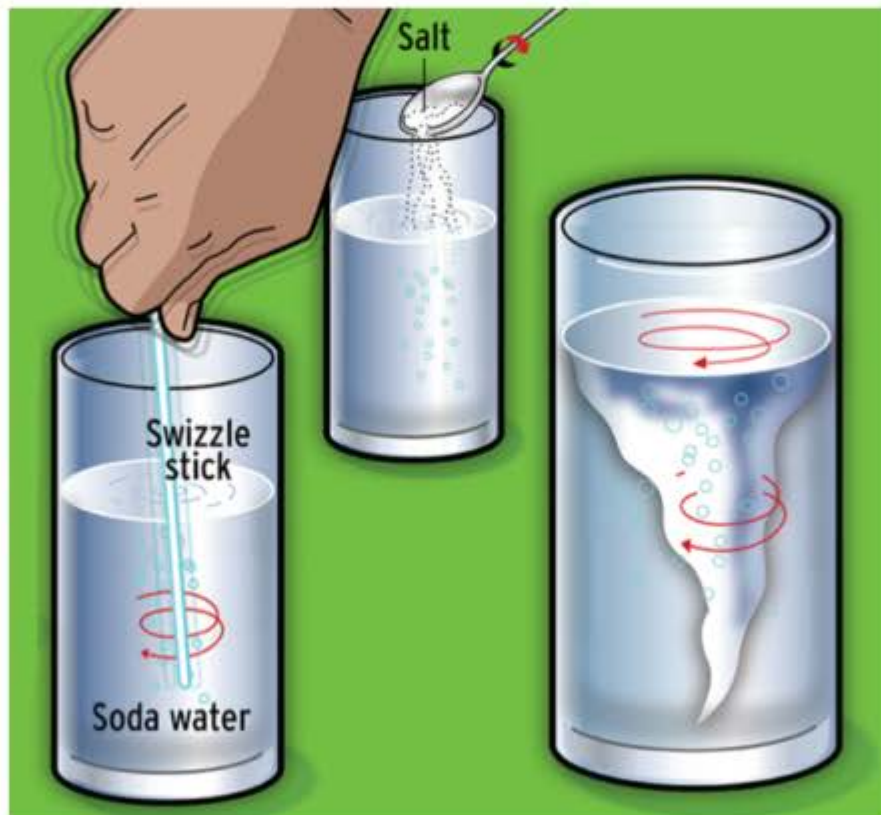


Create a tornado

These past few months we have been learning all about the weather we have attached a fun science experiment to do at home, it sparks children's creative thinking as they predict what would happen once all ingredients are mixed together.

Materials:

- Tall drinking glass
- Bottle of soda water
- Table salt
- Long stirrer



Steps:

- Pour the soda water into the glass until it is 2/3 full
- Use the stirrer to stir the liquid as fast as it can go without spilling over the top, then pour some salt in it.
- Watch the resulting carbon dioxide bubbles form a tornado
