



MATCHSTICK COLOUR SORTING FINE MOTOR TOY



Make a colour sorting fine motor toy using coloured matchsticks to sort and drop! Great for little hands to develop that pincer grasp and, concentration and hand eye co ordination, as well as begin to differentiate and sort by colour. This very simple game uses an empty plastic food container and some coloured matchsticks. Puncture tiny holes into the top of the lid using a toothpick, then widen them a little using the pointed end of a thin paintbrush, until they are just a tiny bit larger than the matchsticks to pass through. use Sharpie markers to colour around each hole to match to the matchsticks and set it up ready to play!
