

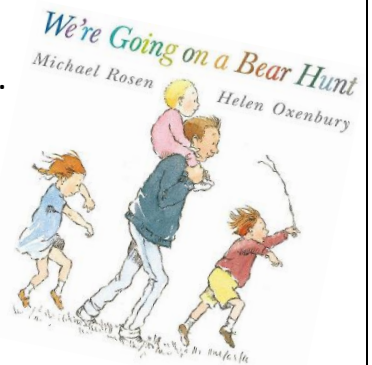


## Take homework sheets- Under 3's

Instructions for puppets:

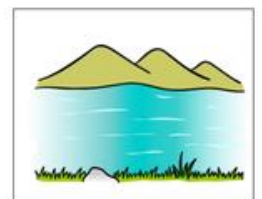
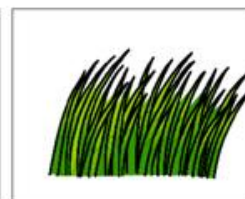
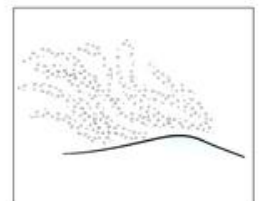
1. Gather all your materials. (Icy pole sticks or straws, scissors, sticky tape, work sheet)

3. Stick the image to the icy pole stick or straw using sticky tape.
4. Cut out the scenes of the book, stick them to the straw or stick using sticky tape.
5. Role play out the book with help from the book or Brigid reading the book to you.

Below is a sheet for the children to cut out and paste into the squares to place the story into order.

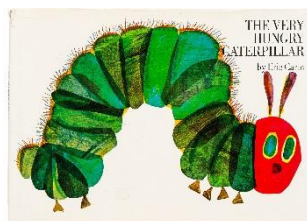
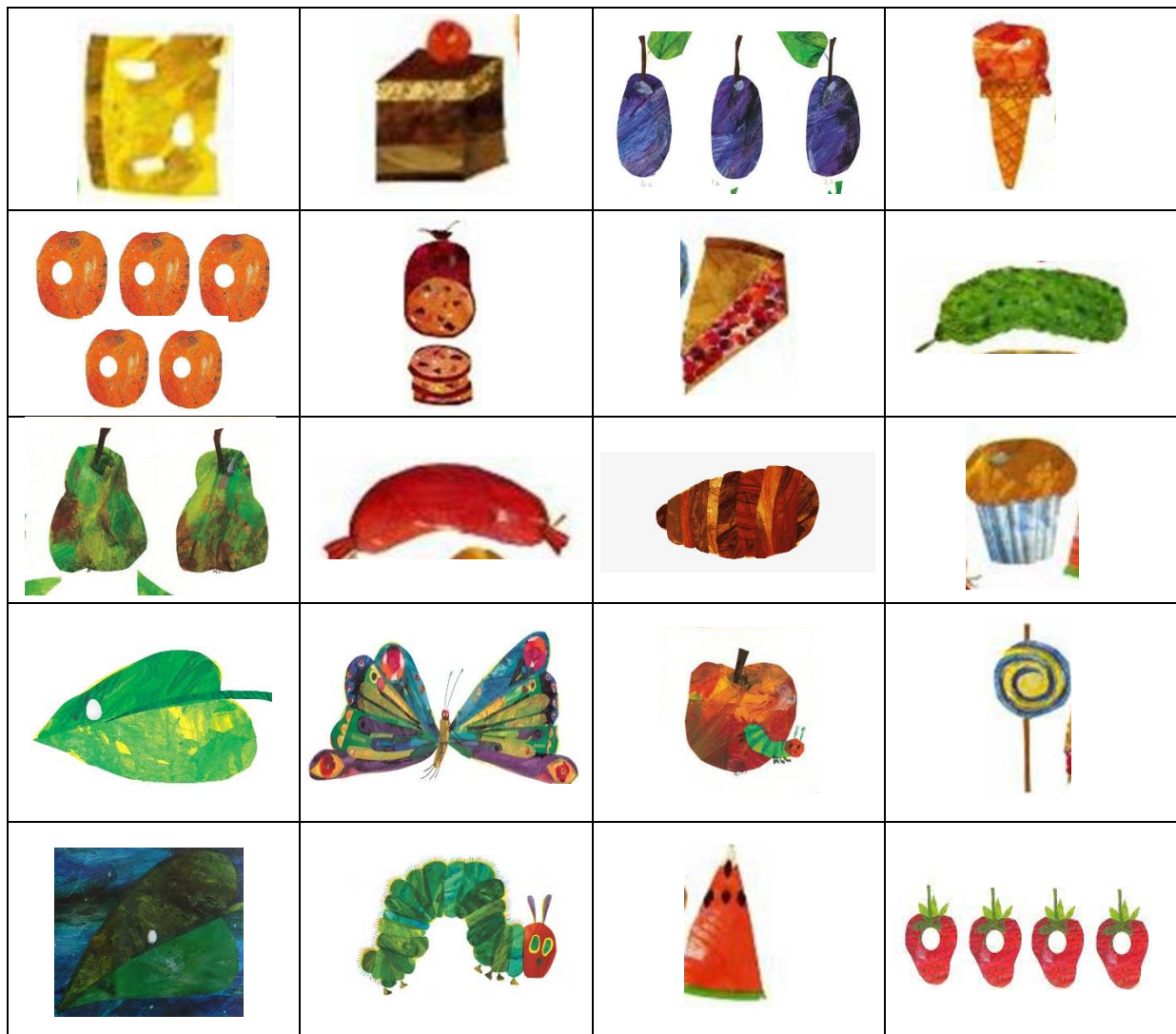
