1. Register to write a letter using the form below, you will then receive a welcome email from our team confirming your registration.
2. Our team will allocate you a recipient and you will receive a nomination email with some non-identifiable information about the recipient. For example: Jack 97, lives alone in Victoria with his best friend Sparky the Jack Russell. Jack enjoys fishing, watching the cricket, and spending time with his family.

NOTE: This email is usually sent within 7 days, but during busy periods it can be longer than 7 days. We thank you for your patience.

3. You write your letter, post it to our team, and we send it to the recipient! You will receive feedback and notifications about your letter along the way!
