

WRITE A BOOK

What you will need:

- Writing paper/blank paper
- Stapler
- Pencils, Texas, crayons, etc.



What to do:

1. Staple several pages together to make a book.
2. Using a favourite picture book, investigate the components of a book.
Talk about the words and the pictures, the cover and the different pages.
3. Challenge your child to write their own book.

What learning is happening:

This activity develops creativity and literacy skills, which encourage a love of reading, writing and learning. Children take a lot of pride in creating their own work, and this would be an amazing keepsake for them to look back on one day.
